TI– 84 Graphing Calculator (optional)– This is the calculator that will be used in class. Personal purchase is optional.

Late work/Retakes

Retakes: Students may re-take any TEST on which they scored less than 70 WITHIN 1 week of its posting. Students must attend at LEAST one tutorial session before retaking the test at lunch. Highest grade earned is 70.

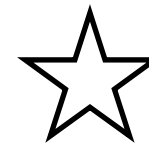
